Re: Audit of the Placement Report of the 2013-15 Post Graduate Diploma in Management (PGDM) programme

We have audited the Placement Report prepared by you for the final placements of students of the 2013-15 batch of the PGDM programme of the FLAME School of Business (FLAME), Pune. The report is the responsibility of FLAME. CRISIL's responsibility is to validate the information provided in the report with the relevant documentation, and comment on the report's conformance with the Indian Placement Reporting Standards (IPRS) version 2.1.

In this context, CRISIL confirms the following:

- 1. For the purpose of the audit, we have obtained all the information and explanations, which, to the best of our knowledge and belief, were necessary. In our opinion, the Placement Report complies with the IPRS version 2.1
- 2. The validation of the information presented in the report is based on the communication received by FLAME from recruiting companies. CRISIL has not independently sourced any information or documentation.
- 3. We have verified the information with respect to remuneration and job function presented in the report with communication received from recruiters. Information regarding compensation received from individual students has not been used. Data regarding location has been verified with communication from recruiters as well as students.
  - a. Where offer letters or other recruiter communication was not available, the report considers the record as "Data not available". Data was not available for one student who sought placements through the institute. We have not been able to verify the status of such student since there is no record.
  - b. The information has been categorised as best as possible under different salary heads as given in the IPRS version 2.1; where a break-up was not available, the salary has been considered only as 'Maximum earning potential'.
  - c. For one student, the offer letter provided did not have company letterhead or signature but information has been used for this report.
- 4. Students' acceptance of the offers has been verified through written communication/email from students.
- 5. Students opting out of the placement process have been established through written communication from the students.
