- 2. The validation of information presented in the report is based on communication received by KJ Somaiya Institute of Management from the recruiting companies. CRISIL has not independently sourced any information or documentation.
- 3. CRISIL has verified the information with respect to remuneration, job function and location presented in the report with communication received from recruiters.
  - a. The information has been categorized as best as possible under various salary heads according to IPRS Version 2.2; where break-up was not available, the salary has been considered only as 'Maximum earning potential'.
  - b. Proof of acceptance of the offers is indicated by students signing the offer letter. The acceptance of offer for 46 students out of 57 could not be verified.
- 4. The number of students opting out of the placement process and students on sabbatical has been established through written communication from the students/recruiting companies.
